Webmaster/Membership Enhancement Input - June 2020 -

Did you ever wish you had just one more up-shift in your transmission?

When the sixth generation Gold Wing was introduced for 2018, there were lots of happy prospective owners due to the addition of a six speed manual transmission and a seven speed 'automatic' transmission. That is all well and good for the new purchaser but what about us with the fifth generation wing, the 2001 through 2017 models? I've always felt that just one more gear would keep the engine from working so hard, make it all better, smoother, quieter, give the engine even more

longevity. But, I guess we are stuck with the same old engine speed of 3100 at 70 MPH and 3600 at 80 MPH... Or are we?

A few years ago, on the, a user asked "Has anyone tried or found a higher gear ratio for the final drive on a GL1500A - 1998?". That kind of sparked a need in a guy in Gardena, California named Henry Park. In Henry's words "The first gear ratio on my GL1800 is too low, like a semi truck, and the engine revs about 3000 rpm at 70 mph and feels like it's in 4th gear. There is a 38% increase in ratio from the first to 2nd gear. I have been doing some research and learned that changing the final drive gear ratio would be a better solution to reducing rpm at high speed."

Henry has been in the Automotive & Off Road Ring & Pinion Business for over 20 years. He's already established and he knows his business. He has the know how to get things built per customers needs/requests. He also runs a very successful US Military Heavy equipment parts business.

He has been working on this Modified Drive for just over 4 years now. He's taken the time to make a proven Drive. By testing it himself on his own bike, and with the help of a few other Beta testers the drive has been 100% successful.

The OEM Honda final drive with a ring gear of 33 teeth and a pinion of 12 teeth has a gear ration of 2.75:1. The modified

drive with ring gear of 32 teeth and a pinion of 14 teeth has a gear ratio of 2.286 to 1.





Externally, the modified drive is identical to the OEM drive. Internally is where the changes were made. The bore for the pinion shaft and bearing needed to be increased to fit the larger 14T pinion gear. I believe the ring gear diameter stays the same but the number of teeth changed. The following will give you an idea of what this gear change does to the RPM and speed of the 5th Generation Gold Wing.

Of course, the speedometer will need correction if this drive is installed? If the speedometer is left uncorrected with this particular modified drive on your swing arm, your speedometer will read almost 10 MPH slow. The easy way to fix that is with a 12oclockLabs Speedometer Corrector. The speedometer corrector is plug and play and only requires some minor calibration after installation.




By doing the above you are also practicing self-defense for riders, and following the Motorist Awareness practices, that make for a good rider, and driver.

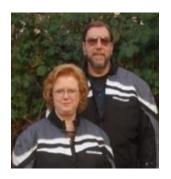
