MAY 2022 – MAINTEANCE DAY

Our well attended April gathering this past month was the prelude to our combined WA-A & WA-V Maintenance Day in Don's garage. Eleven of us on our bikes trekked over to Don's Garage for the festivities.

Activities included headset intercom troubleshooting and diagnosis for Bill C. Fork removal, disassembly for seals, bushings, and fluid replacement and then reassembly and installation for Jeff's GL1800. Special shout out to Gary B. Thanks to him, Jeff had the necessary parts to complete the job on his GL1800. After the forks were reinstalled, final drive fluid was replaced. It was about seven hours of work which Jeff did pretty much un-assisted. Good job Jeff.

Dennis M. and Mike B. installed some balancing beads in Dennis's 2018 GL1800's tires. Dennis said he had been experiencing a less than smooth ride since installing new tires and wanted to see if the balancing beads would help. On the ride home that evening, he realized that the balancing beads had done their job. The ride was noticeably much smoother.

Ron H. had a big task ahead of him on his newly acquired 2012 GL1800. His plan was to replace the fork stem bearings with tapered bearings. this required a lot of disassembly. He has the singular distinction of longest duration work performed during one of our maintenance days since 2014.

Ron completed the work on his bike in about twelve hours counting a lunch break. And, there were only three screws left over when finished.

In Ron's defense, back in 2014 Mike Blangy tackled fork rebuilding on his 2004 GL1800. Unfortunately, he didn't have all the necessary parts or tools to do the job so there was a trip or two to the local Honda shop for supplies which extended the project more than expected. That task was completed somewhere around 11:30 pm that evening.

Lunch consisted of delicious gourmet burgers, chicken shish kabob skewers and all-American hot dogs. Plenty of delicious salads and desserts were supplied by the riders and co-riders of WA-A and WA-V. So much food was available that we couldn't eat it all. Much of it had to be taken home by our members for further enjoyment.

How was all this paid for you ask? Well, the ladies had a special surprise. They orchestrated a 50/50 and they put together a few baskets of donated goodies for a silent auction. The funds from the 50/50 and the silent auction was more than enough to fund the day of food, fun and skinned knuckles.


































