I love riding in the summer, but road construction does get in the way. The 39<sup>th</sup> Annual Buzzard Butt Buster is in the books. Mindy, Todd, Jesse and Eva, Todd and Lisa, Pat and Ruth and I have completed at least seven years of camaraderie on this annual event. It is rumored that the 40<sup>th</sup> will be the last but only time will tell. As with all things, nothing lasts forever.



This year we rode to Moses Lake, then headed southwest to Goldendale and from there east to the Clearwater River Casino & Lodge in Lewiston, Idaho for the banquet. Three days of riding and two nights of partying with friends and then one last long ride home on day four.

Day one of our four-day ride was a little bit of an eye opener. Someone decided we should go over Cayuse and Chinook passes instead of White Pass on Hwy 12. The feeling was that the route over White Pass always seems to be less than motorcycle friendly.

Well, I'm here to tell you that taking Hwy 123 to Hwy 410 was a poor decision. Hwy 123 between Hwy 12 and Hwy 410 is no bueno. Two miles of the asphalt was being replaced and we were attempting to travel in the middle of their work schedule.

The road was scheduled to be closed on Saturday and Sunday, 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>, for the paving completion, but this was Thursday and the crew was tearing things up. Hwy 123 was under some pretty heavy construction. We were stopped for about 10 minutes while we waited for traffic from the other direction to roll through. Then it was our turn to roll through the gravel for the next two miles and then be stuck in a long line of vehicles until we got to Cayuse pass to make the turn onto Hwy 410. Once we were able to get on Hwy 410, things got better.

On the plus side, it was a great decision not to travel over I-90. The Vantage bridge in both directions from milepost 136 to 138 had continuous single-lane closures. From reports we heard, it was up to a three-hour delay for our fellow riders that took that route.

And on our route from Moses Lake to Goldendale, we took US 395 towards I-82 to Hwy 14. The Columbia River Bridge into Oregon had a single lane closure and was causing a big delay on US 395. Luckily the backup was within a few hundred feet of the exit to Hwy 14 and we exited without much of a delay.

The stay in Goldendale was a bit of a problem for Todd. The Quality Inn & Suites was booked up solid when Todd got around to making a reservation back in April. The so he contacted the

Ponderosa Motel which was less than ¾ of as mile ways and made his reservation. No big deal, right? Wrong. They cancelled his reservation on the day he made it and didn't tell him. It was really a third-rate motel anyway, the kind that makes you want to check the sheets for bed bugs. We moved rooms around amongst us at the Quality Inn and got him a place to stay. Luckily, there were no issues at all at the Casino. It was a perfect place to end the 39<sup>th</sup> Annual Buzzard Butt Buster. Great banquet. I hope it is just as good for the 40<sup>th</sup> in 2026.

It has been a busy summer and I am ready for some R and R at Squaw Rock. It was great time last year and should be the same this year too. If you haven't done so or thought about it then you should go too.

I was riding to work and noticed that the bike was riding kind of funny. I checked the tire pressure and found a nail in my back tire. It was a slow leak but definitely noticeable. I figured that I would take it off and take it to my friend Dave Taylor at 410 Moto.

I could take it off but I couldn't get it out from underneath the bike with the hitch and amp in the way. I have seen on Youtube, people just laying the bike on it's side and sliding it out. I wasn't really willing to do that. So, I put the wheel back on and took the whole bike to Dave.

He plugged and patched the tire and I ordered a new set of Dunlops from him.

One week later it went back to him and he changed them both while Sharon and I went to breakfast. Nothing like having a new pair of shoes!

This Wing, being a 2015 has a tire pressure monitoring system on it but it really lacks in the information department. Basically, it just tells you that it has a low tire. It doesn't even tell you if it's the front or back. This system was bypassed long ago because the batteries needed to be changed and it was on all of the time. And I had different wheels on it too.

I used to have the Fobo TPMS on my 2012 and when I traded in for the 2019, I sold it.

Time for another set up for both bikes. I got them from Amazon and it seems to me that the price went down a lot from when I had the system before. You can get them for 2,3,4 or more wheels.

The system works with an App. Set up is super simple.

The app will tell you the tire pressure, when cold or hot and will let you know when the tire is below the pressure that you have selected for that particular wheel. It sounds an alarm to let you know if it gets below the preset pressure.

It will also let you know the temperature of the individual wheels.

It's a nice setup and very user friendly. Check it out on Amazon.




### Who Is Hamburger Harry?


