## The traditional riding season is about over, but not for everyone.

At the request of the Chapter Director, the after-meeting ride for August was the Puppy Ride. The Five Aces Ice Cream Ride on the 30<sup>th</sup> of August was next. Then the Squaw Rock Camp Out was September 5<sup>th</sup> through the 8<sup>th</sup>. Upcoming in late September will be the Anacortes Oyster Run. After that, there are no real rides scheduled until the end of November when we will have a Five Aces Ice Cream Ride, weather permitting.

The after-meeting ride was successful, I think. The weather was very nice, and we had nine bikes and eleven riders/co-riders to the best of my recollection. We had both Chapter A and C folks on the ride. At the end of the ride, we stopped at the Maple Valley Dairy Queen for some much-needed refreshment (Ice Cream).

The Five Aces Ice Cream Ride was well attended. I didn't take note of all that were there, but I think we had thirteen bikes and fifteen riders/co-riders. We started at McDonalds Restaurant in Tacoma. From there we rode to the Copper Creek restaurant in Ashford. After blackberry pie and ice cream, some of the Chapter C folks left us to find their own way home. It tuns out though that they pretty much took the same route we did.

I have to say that the ride to Copper Creek was probably one of the best rides we have had lately. Never once did we get split up on the road by four wheelers. That was quite a feat since we had thirteen bikes. Good job guys.

On the fourth of September, a few of us rode to Squaw Rock Campground to start our four-night, five-day fun weekend. On the ride to the campground, however, we encountered lots of smoke in the air on Hwy 410 caused by the Wildcat Fire near Bumping Lake. I was thinking that if it didn't get much better that this was going to be a lousy weekend. I had thoughts of bagging the whole idea and turning around and heading home. Luckily, the wind shifted, and the smoke cleared somewhat on Thursday evening and by Saturday morning, we were treated to clear blue skies. As of September 19<sup>th</sup>, the Wildcat fire has burned 8,849 acres of wilderness and is still only 8% contained.

Most of us had reserved cabins to stay in and there were three fifth-wheelers and a coach in the mix as well. All told there were twenty-eight people that attended. On Saturday morning, Vonda made biscuits and gravy for whoever wanted to join her and Gary. Saturday evening's meal was prepared by many and was funded by Washington district. Vonda also offered to make scrambled eggs on Sunday morning for anyone that was interested. Thank you, Vonda. Dennis and I had coffee, waffles and bacon Friday, Sunday and Monday.

There were rides on Saturday and Sunday. Saturday was a ride to Packwood and back. I don't know what everyone did in Packwood though; I bailed early. Sunday's ride was to Winegars Ice Cream in Ellensburg.

The ride on Sunday was supposed to be over Hwy 123 but since it was closed due to construction, the route to Winegars was the best alternative. The wonderfully winding ride to and from Winegars was the same in both directions but it always looks different on the flip side. Evening entertainment for the weekend was lots of conversation, Dennis's battery-operated bug zapper and considerable adult beverage consumption along with entertaining games of Joker's and Marbles. Talk to Vonda about the Jokers and Marbles game and you'll have to ask Dennis about his battery-operated Bug Zapper.

The ride home on Monday was much pretty much smoke free. There was very little traffic on Hwy 410 Auburn. The construction and traffic due to the White River detour really slowed things down. 
