Re: STOP SALE NOTICE: 2018 - 2021 GL1800 GOLDWING SAFETY RECALL

Dear Honda Dealer:

Honda is issuing a STOP SALE NOTICE on CERTAIN 2018 - 2021 GL1800 Goldwing motorcycles to replace the primary drive gear bolt. Due to a manufacturing defect, the primary drive bolt may fail during use and cause the engine to stall while riding, increasing the risk of a crash or injury.

Effective immediately, you MUST NOT SELL any affected NEW or USED 2018 - 2021 GL1800 Goldwing motorcycle until it is repaired, according to the associated Service Bulletin.

AFFECTED UNITS

CERTAIN NEW or USED 2018 - 2021 GL1800 Goldwing motorcycles:

- To search for applicable updates or recalls on a specific unit, you MUST use Unit Information on iN.
- To manage your affected inventory, use your dealer eResponsibility Report on iN.

SERVICE BULLETIN

Service Bulletin: GL1800 #29, which includes all the information relating to this Safety Recall, is expected to be issued in November 2024.

PARTS INFORMATION

The parts needed for the repair can be ordered according to the instructions in the forthcoming Service Bulletin.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

American Honda intends to mail customer letters to all owners of affected 2018 - 2021 GL1800 Goldwing motorcycles in January 2025. The letter will inform customers that their motorcycle may be affected by a safety-related defect and advise them to make an appointment with an authorized Honda dealer for repair.

Make sure all departments in your dealership are aware of this Safety Recall.
